



2017 CDYST Masters Wrap-up

Jeh'ron Cherry of Albany defeated Tom Hankey of Great Barrington, MA 250 – 234 and then 247 – 153 to win the CDYST Masters tournament held on Saturday, May 13th at Town 'n Country Lanes.

Following a six-game qualifying round, the top 16 bowlers competed in single-game matches within a double-elimination format. In Round 4, Hankey edged Cherry 245 – 236 for his fourth consecutive victory to qualify for the Championship Round as the sole remaining undefeated bowler. In Round 5, Cherry rebounded to defeat Christian Chiarito of Schenectady 192 – 172; while Haley Groat of Mechanicville defeated Hunter Kempton of Buzzards Bay, MA 235 – 214. Kempton and Chiarito earned \$200 scholarships for finishing fourth and fifth, respectively. Cherry then defeated Groat 205 – 186 to set up the rematch with Hankey in the Championship Round. Groat earned a \$300 scholarship for finishing third.

Being undefeated, Hankey had to win one match in the Championship Round to earn the title; Cherry had to win two. Cherry began with seven consecutive strikes and held a 53-pin lead. Hankey rallied with four consecutive strikes in the eighth through tenth frames to force Cherry to mark in the tenth frame to win. He responded with two strikes to force a second game. In the deciding match, Cherry began with three strikes in the first four frames to jump out to a 25-pin lead. Cherry increased his lead to 36 pins after five frames; and then pulled away with five consecutive strikes in the fifth through tenth frames to clinch his first CDYST title and a \$1,000 scholarship. Hankey won a \$550 scholarship for his runner-up effort.

During the qualifying round, the top four boys and top four girls earned respective scholarship prizes of \$150, 100, \$75, and \$50. Those respective prizes were won by Billy McGaffin of Amsterdam, Hankey, Kempton, and Chiarito in the Boys Division; and Mariah Williams of Bloomington, Lauren Piotrowski of Schenectady, Groat, and Amanda Chrzanowski of Schenectady in the Girls Division.

The 2017 CDYST Masters was the final event of our seventh season. A field of 37 bowlers competed and earned a scholarship fund of \$4,425. The top 19 bowlers earned scholarship prizes of at least \$50. Throughout the season, our talented youth bowlers earned \$23,065 in scholarships. We have now awarded over \$120,000 in the seven years since our first event in May 2010.

Kempton's fourth place enabled him to become the 2016 – 2017 CDYST Bowler of the Year. During the season, he won a season high four titles; had the second highest average of 198.42 over 109 games; and tied for the highest number of match play victories (21).

The top eight bowlers in the final Bowler of the Year standings will represent the CDYST in the 2017 USBC Youth Open Championships being held in Cleveland in July. The bowlers will form two four-bowler teams, as well as four doubles teams, prior to competing in singles and all-events competitions.

The 2016 – 2017 CDYST season is complete; the eighth season will begin in early fall. 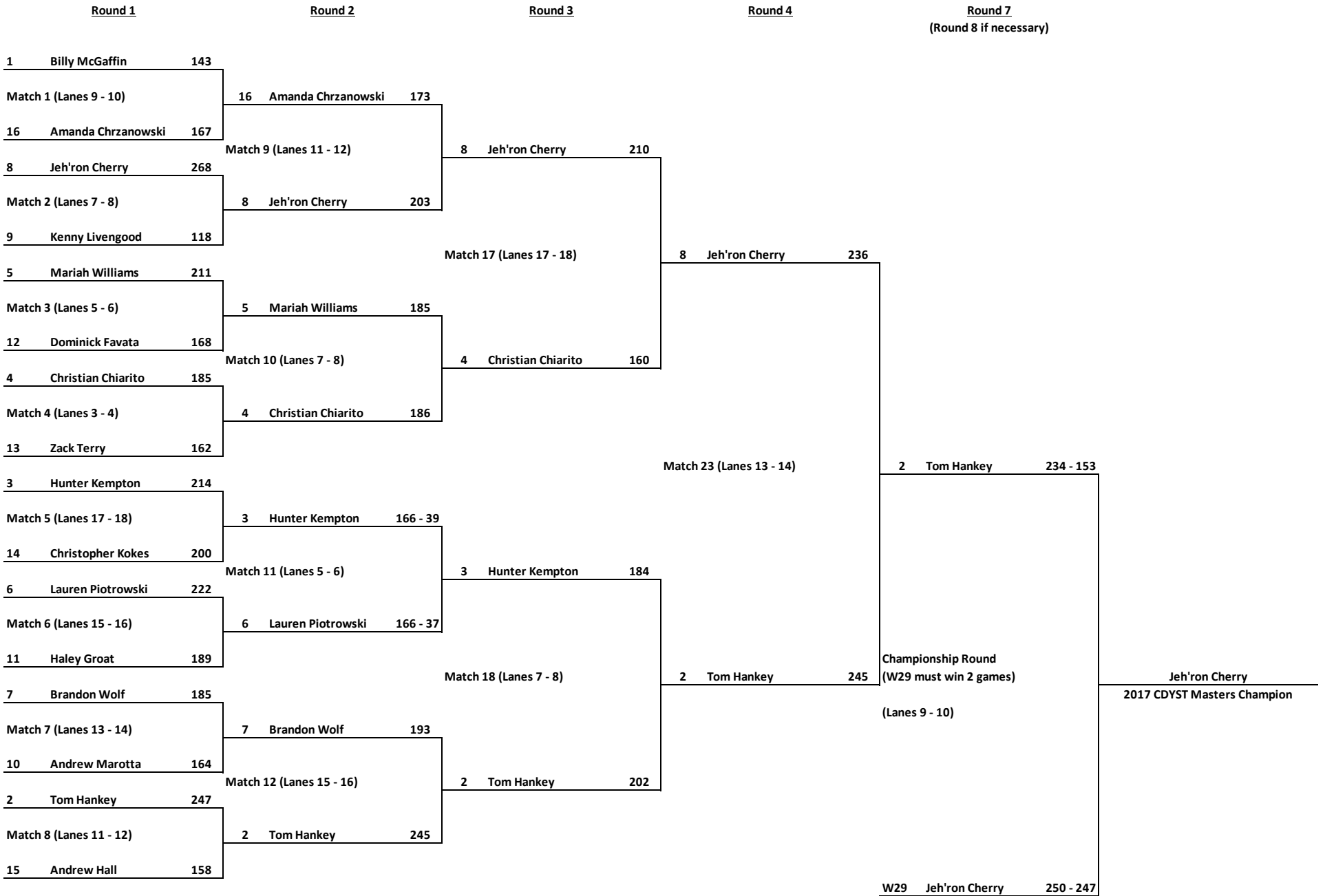

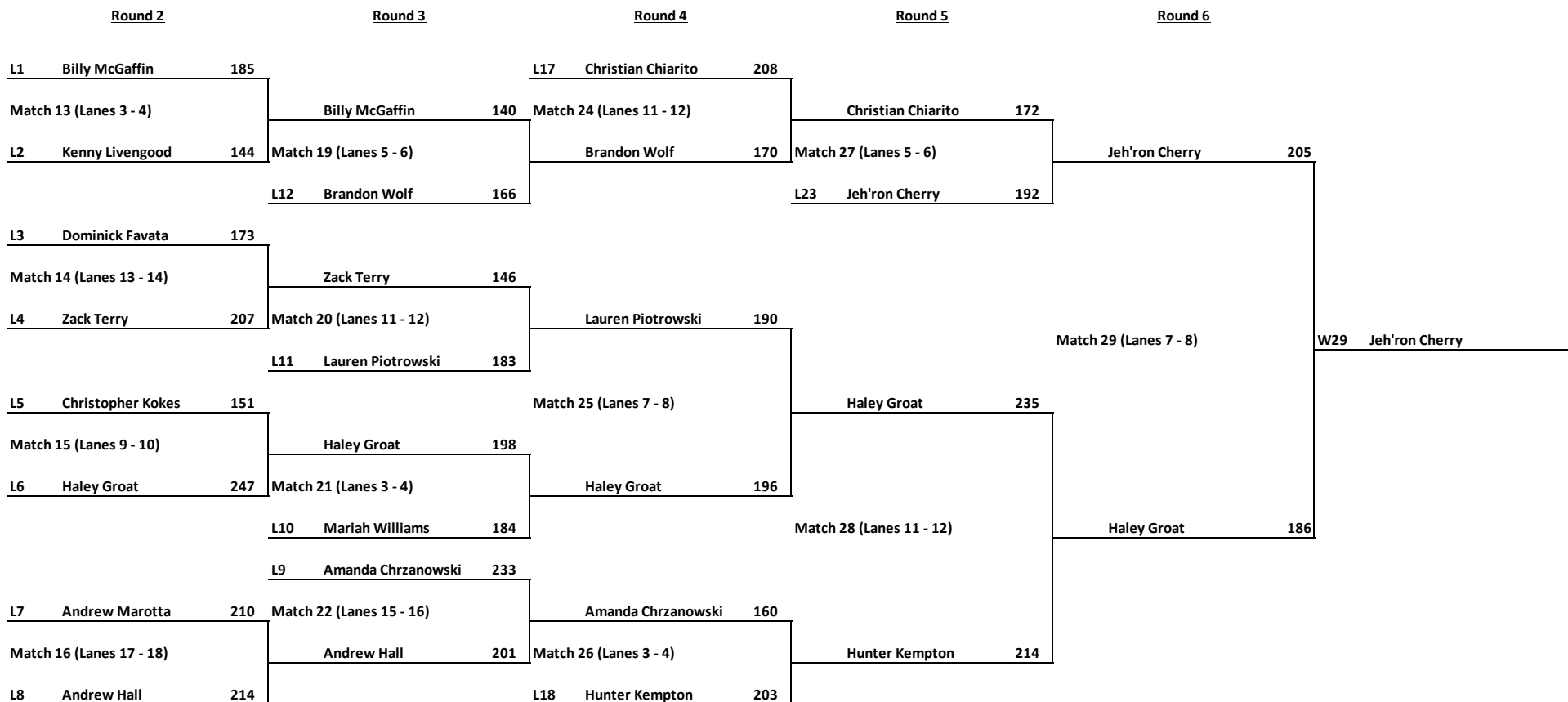
