



October 2017 E. Greenbush Bowling Center Tournament Wrap-up

Lauren Piotrowski of Schenectady defeated Nate Purches of Marlboro, MA to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at East Greenbush Bowling Center on Saturday, October 7th.

The stepladder finals began with the third-seeded Purches (U15 Boys) defeating fourth-seeded Zachary Bogholtz of Nassau 229 – 157. Bogholtz earned \$50 in scholarships for finishing second in the Under-15 Boys Division and fourth overall. Purches then defeated the second-seeded Brandon Wolf 195 – 187 to set up the title match. Wolf won a \$150 in scholarships for finishing first in the Under-20 Boys Division and third overall.

In a title match that was tied through four frames, Piotrowski rolled three consecutive strikes in the fifth through seventh frames to surge into a 32-pin lead. Spares in the eighth and ninth frames enabled her to win her first CDYST title and earn \$150 in scholarships for finishing first overall and in the Under-20 Girls Division. Purches won \$110 in scholarships for finishing first in the Under-15 Boys Division and as the runner-up overall.

Competing in a six-game qualifying round on the sport-level, 2012 Youth London International tournament pattern; Purches jumped out to the lead following Game 1 and would retain it throughout qualifying. In the semifinals, Piotrowski rolled a 256 to win her first match and vault ahead. She would go on to split her final two matches to retain the lead and earn the top seed for the finals. Wolf won all three of his semifinal matches to earn the second seed; while Purches earned the third seed. Bogholtz won two of his three matches to rise from tenth place after qualifying and into fourth.

A total of 31 bowlers (15 U20 Boys, 6 U20 Girls, 6 U15 Boys, and 4 U15 Girls) competed in the second tournament of the season. The remaining scholarship winners in the Under-20 Boys Division are Matthew Flandreau of Voorheesville (\$75) in second place (sixth overall); and Ryan Aylesworth of Homer (\$40) in third (seventh overall). Jessica Shufelt of Watervliet finished second in the Under-20 Girls Division (tenth overall) and earned a \$35 scholarship; and Sydney Reardon of New Milford, CT won a \$65 scholarship for finishing first in the Under-15 Girls Division (21st overall). Our talented youth bowlers earned \$775 in scholarships; bringing the season total to \$1,535.

Wolf, Bogholtz, Phillip Decker III of Leeds, and Mykal Brunelle of Fort Edward earned entries into the 2018 USBC Junior Gold Championships to be held in Dallas.

Our next tournament will begin at 1:00 pm on Saturday October 28th at Kingpin's Alley in South Glens Falls.
