

2013 CDYST Masters Wrap-up

Patrick DeVoe of Delmar went 7 – 1 in the match play finals, including 200 – 197 and 189 – 184 Championship Round victories over Christopher Hanson of Ballston Lake, to win the CDYST Masters tournament held on Saturday, April 27th at Town 'n Country Lanes.

Following a six-game qualifying round, the top 16 bowlers competed in single-game matches with a double-elimination format. In Round 4, Hanson defeated DeVoe 231 – 145 to earn a berth into the Championship Round as the sole remaining undefeated bowler. In Round 5, DeVoe defeated Natasha Bidwell of Schenectady 185 – 170; and Jonathan Bowman of Peru, NY defeated Corey Buckley of Albany 212 – 163. Bidwell and Buckley earned \$175 scholarships for finishing fourth and fifth, respectively. DeVoe then defeated Bowman 175 - 170 to set up the Championship Round. Bowman earned a \$325 scholarship for his third place finish.

Since Hanson was undefeated, he had to win one match in the Championship Round to claim the title. DeVoe began the first match with an early double to open up a 32-pin lead after four frames. Hanson responded with five strikes in a row from frames five through nine to take an 18-pin lead. However, DeVoe rolled strikes in the ninth and tenth frames to defeat Hanson 200 – 197 and force a second match.

Hanson began the second match with four strikes in the first five frames, but DeVoe started with five marks to lead by one pin at the halfway point. DeVoe converted spares in frames six through eight to extend his lead to 15 pins. Finishing the match first, DeVoe rolled a strike in the ninth frame. However, when he did not do so on his first ball in the tenth, Hanson could strike on his first ball in the tenth frame to win the title. However, he left a solid nine-pin enabling DeVoe to earn his first CDYST title and a \$900 scholarship. Hanson won a \$550 scholarship for his runner-up finish.

Hanson earned an additional \$100 for leading the qualifying round with a 1239 series. Bowman won an additional \$50 for being the second highest qualifier. Buckley and Christopher Radliff of Schenectady earned entries into the 2013 USBC Junior Gold national tournament to be held in Detroit, MI.

The invitational CDYST Masters was the final event of our third season; 29 bowlers competed for a record scholarship fund of \$3,190 and the top 16 earned prizes of at least \$50. Throughout the season, our talented youth bowlers earned a record \$14,718 in scholarships.

Hanson's second place finish enabled him to win the 2012 – 2013 Bowler of the Year by 55 points over Zachary Doty of Nassau. He also won the 2010 – 2011 award. Bowman and Austin Van Buren of Altamont finished tied for third. For their season-long performance, these bowlers earned entries into the Bowlers of Eastern Scholarship Tours tournament in Maple Shade, New Jersey.

The 2012 – 2013 CDYST season is officially complete; the fourth season will begin in the early fall. However, CDYST is introducing the 2013 Spring Series, which are two five-game sweeper events that will be hosted on Saturday May 11th (10 am) at Del Lanes and Sunday May 19th (12 noon) at Hi-Way Recreation. Any USBC youth bowler will have the opportunity to compete for 2013 Junior Gold entries, scholarship money, or both. 


