2011 CDYST Masters Tournament Wrap-up

Christopher Hanson of Ballston Lake went 5 – 0 in the match play finals, including a 213 – 188 Championship Round victory over Casey Schoonmaker of Albany, to win the CDYST Masters tournament held on Saturday, May 14th at Town 'n Country Lanes. For winning his second CDYST title, Hanson earned a \$750 scholarship. Schoonmaker used a 5 – 2 record to earn his third runner-up finish of the season, and a \$425 scholarship.

The top 16 bowlers after a five-game qualifying round competed in single-game matches with a double-elimination format. In Round 5, Justin Carl of Albany defeated Scott Frament of East Greenbush 196 – 170 and Schoonmaker defeated Corey Buckley of Albany 216 – 200. Buckley and Frament earned \$125 scholarships for finishing fourth and fifth, respectively. Schoonmaker then defeated Carl 212 – 185 to set up the Championship Round. Carl earned a \$225 scholarship for his third place finish.

Hanson was the sole remaining undefeated bowler and therefore had to win only one game to claim the title. The first game was close throughout, with neither bowler leading by more than 10 pins during the first six frames. Schoonmaker, on a five-match winning streak and looking to force a second game, rolled strikes in the sixth through eighth frames for an 11-pin lead. Hanson responded with strikes in the eighth, ninth, and tenth frames to surge into the lead and finish the season in the same way he started it, with a title.

Competing on the Kegel Autobahn sport lane condition, several high scores were rolled, notably Stephen LaMalfa of Scotia and Justin Carl with 279 games and Amber Dominic of Latham with a 278. Carl earned an additional \$100 scholarship for leading the qualifying round with an 1161 series; Hanson had 1155 to claim an additional \$50 scholarship for being the second qualifier; Rovelli and Matt Olson of Schenectady rolled 1154 and 1129, respectively.

The invitational CDYST Masters was the culmination of a very successful inaugural season; 19 bowlers competed for a prize fund of over \$2,200 and the top 12 bowlers earned scholarships of at least \$50. Throughout the season, our talented youth bowlers earned \$6,335 in scholarships.

In the season-long Bowler of the Year race, Rovelli led by 46 points prior to the Masters; his sixth-place finish meant that Hanson was the only bowler who could pass him, but needed a victory to do so. Being up to the challenge, Hanson edged Rovelli by 9 points to earn the Bowler of the Year title.

The CDYST is now on hiatus through the summer months, with the second season to start in the early fall. The new schedule will be available later this summer. 
