2016 Alpha Lanes Tournament Wrap-up

Christopher Radliff of Schenectady won three matches in the stepladder finals; including a 275 – 179 victory over tournament leader Jeh’ron Cherry of Albany to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Alpha Lanes on Saturday, January 23rd.

The stepladder finals began with the third-seeded Radliff rolling three strikes in the tenth frame to edge fourth-seeded Jordan West of Cohoes 180 – 172. West won a \$75 scholarship for finishing fourth in the Boys Division. Radliff then defeated Justin Carl of Albany 210 – 174 to advance to the title match. Carl earned a \$100 scholarship for finishing third.

In the championship match, Radliff began with four consecutive strikes to open up a 50-pin lead. Following a spare in the fifth frame, he rolled the last seven strikes to extend his lead and win his third career title (third of the season) and a \$275 scholarship as the top finisher in the Boys Division. Cherry won a \$150 scholarship for his runner-up finish.

Tom Hankey of Great Barrington, MA began his day with a 257 and led the field throughout the four-game qualifying round. In the semifinals, Cherry won two of his three matches, including a 254 in his final game that vaulted him from fifth place into the top seed heading into the finals. Carl and Radliff each won two matches to earn the second and third seeds, respectively. West won his final match to become the fourth seed.

A field of 51 bowlers (37 boys and 14 girls) competed in our eighth tournament of the season and earned \$1,170 in scholarships; bringing the season total to \$11,070.

Additional scholarship winners in the Boys Division are as follows: Justin Bink of Albany (\$50) in fifth place; Hankey (\$40) in sixth; Brandon Wolf of Schenectady (\$35) in seventh (ninth overall); and Andrew Marotta of Ballston Spa (\$35) in eighth (tenth overall). Scholarship winners in the Girls Division are as follows Katie Lynch of Troy (\$125) in first place (seventh overall); Jordan Byrnes of Kinderhook (\$75) in second (eighth overall); Lauren Piotrowski of Schenectady (\$50) in third (14th overall); and Melanie Lemke of Delmar (\$35) in fourth (22nd overall).

Our next tournament will begin at 1:30 pm on Saturday February 13, 2016 at Sportsmans Bowl in Rotterdam. It will also offer optional Junior Gold qualifying for any 2015 – 2016 CDYST members who have competed in at least two prior tournaments this season. 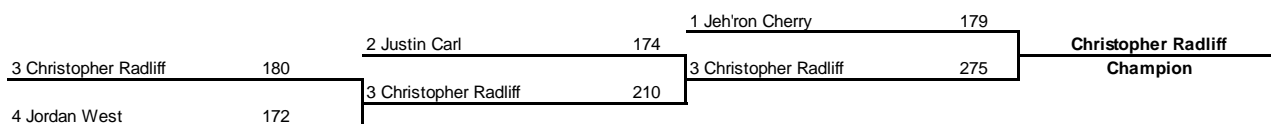
