



2013 Alpha Lanes Tournament Wrap-up

Jalen Scott-Jones of East Providence, RI defeated Amber Dominic of Latham 266 - 203 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Alpha Lanes on Saturday, January 5th.

The stepladder finals began with the third-seeded Dominic defeating fourth-seeded Jovanni Scaccia of Schenectady 222 - 179. Scaccia earned a \$100 scholarship for finishing fourth. Dominic then defeated second-seeded Austin Van Buren of Altamont 234 - 206 and set up the title match. Van Buren earned a \$150 scholarship for finishing third.

The top-seeded Scott-Jones rolled the first nine strikes in the championship match to surge to his first CDYST title and a \$325 scholarship. Dominic, who competed in the title match at Alpha Lanes for the third consecutive year, earned a \$200 scholarship for her runner-up finish.

In the qualifying round, Casey Schoonmaker of Albany and Ryan Bekkering of Glenville were early leaders; Scaccia took the lead in Game 3 and topped the field heading into the semifinals. Scott-Jones then won all three of his semifinal matches to vault into the top spot after Game 5 and open up a 95-pin lead. Van Buren also went 3 - 0 to jump from ninth place and earn the second seed. Dominic and Scaccia went 3 - 0 and 2 - 1, respectively, to continue their steady performances and earn the remaining berths into the stepladder finals.

A record-tying 49 bowlers competed in the sixth of ten 2012 - 2013 regular season tournaments. Liz Kuhlkin of Schenectady finished fifth but could not accept her scholarship prize because of NCAA regulations. Qwadaris Rembert of Providence, RI earned a \$75 scholarship for finishing sixth; Jonathan Bowman of Peru, NY won a \$50 scholarship for finishing seventh; Justin Carl of Albany won a \$40 scholarship for finishing eighth; Christopher Hanson of Ballston Lake and Michael Hartmann of Earlton earned \$35 scholarships for finishing ninth and tenth, respectively; Casey Schoonmaker of Albany and Morgan Ruggeri of Johnstown won \$30 scholarships for finishing eleventh and twelfth, respectively. A regular season tournament record \$1,215 in scholarships was awarded to our talented youth bowlers, bringing the season total to \$8,423.

The next tournament will be held at 1:00 pm on Saturday, January 26th at Burnt Hills Lanes. This event will offer an extended qualifying round and optional Junior Gold qualifying for all CDYST members who have competed in at least two prior tournaments during the 2012 - 2013 season.
