



## 2011 Del Lanes Tournament Wrap-up

Michael Hartmann of Earlton defeated Ricky Rovelli of Albany 223 - 189 to win his first CDYST title in the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Del Lanes on Saturday, December 3rd.

The stepladder finals began with the fourth-seeded Scott Lansing of Latham rolling the last seven strikes to defeat third-seeded Brandon Wright of Glenmont 259 - 169. Wright earned a \$60 scholarship for finishing fourth. The second-seeded Hartmann then defeated Lansing 235 - 222 to set up the title match. Lansing earned a \$90 scholarship for finishing third.

In the championship match, both competitors began with marks in four of the first five frames; Rovelli led by 3 pins. Strikes in each of the next three frames for each bowler kept the match tight; Hartmann then rolled another strike in the pivotal ninth frame to take control of the match and surge to victory and a \$200 scholarship. Rovelli earned a \$125 scholarship for his second place finish.

Steady performances by Hartmann, Lansing, and Wright enabled them to remain within the top four throughout the day, with Lansing and Wright trading the lead during the Qualifying Round. Hartmann rolled a 265 in his first semifinal match to take the lead, but Rovelli used a 3 - 0 match play record in the semifinals to complete his rise from 20th place after two games, to the top seed heading into the finals.

There were 26 entries in the fifth of ten tournaments during the 2011 - 2012 season. Christopher Hanson of Ballston Lake earned a \$40 scholarship for finishing fifth and Stephen LaMalfa won a \$30 scholarship for finishing sixth. A total of \$665 in scholarships was awarded to our talented youth bowlers, bringing the season total to \$3,070, and enabling us to surpass the \$10,000 mark since our kickoff in May 2010.

Our next event is the inaugural CDYST Holiday Open at Towne Bowling Academy on December 28th and 29th. Bowlers may compete anytime, with unlimited re-entries, between 10 am and 2 pm on either day. An additional \$500 will be added to the scholarship fund of this special event. Our next regular season tournament will be held at 1:00 pm on Saturday, January 7, 2012 at Alpha Lanes in Troy.
