



2016 East Greenbush Bowling Center Tournament Wrap-up

Andrew Hall of Westborough, MA capped off a wire-to-wire victory by defeating Christopher Radliff of Schenectady 278 - 180 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at East Greenbush Bowling Center on Saturday, April 9th.

The stepladder finals began with the third-seeded Radliff defeating fourth-seeded Zack Terry of Schenectady 187 - 159. Terry won a \$75 scholarship for finishing fourth in the Boys Division. Radliff then defeated second-seeded Billy McGaffin of Amsterdam 171 - 164 to set up the title match. McGaffin earned a \$100 scholarship for finishing third in the Boys Division.

In the title match, Hall began with three strikes to jump out to a 33-pin lead. Following a spare in the fourth frame, he rolled seven consecutive strikes to pull away and win his second title of the season (second career) and a \$275 scholarship as the top finisher in the Boys division. Radliff earned a \$150 scholarship for his runner-up finish.

Competing in a six-game qualifying round on the WTBA Stockholm sport-compliant lane condition, Hall began with games of 279, 235, 245, and 268 for the second highest four-game series in CDYST history with 1,027. He finished the qualifying round with games of 182 and 259 for a 1,468 six-game series and a 192-pin lead heading into the semifinals. With a 257 in his first match, Hall's seven-game series (1,725) became the second highest ever in a CDYST event. He completed the semifinals with three consecutive victories and a 275-pin lead over the second-seeded McGaffin, who also won all three of his matches. Radliff won two of his three matches to become the third seed; while Terry was unbeaten and rose from twelfth after qualifying into fourth place.

A total of 51 bowlers (36 boys and 15 girls) competed in the final open event of the season. The remaining scholarship winners in the Boys Division are as follows: Zachery Porter of Schenectady (\$50) in fifth place; Kenny Livengood of Ravena (\$45) in sixth; and Hunter Kempton of Buzzard's Bay, MA (\$40) in seventh. In the Girls Division, Britaney Myers of Mechanicville finished first (14th overall) and won a \$150 scholarship; Jenna Lemke of Delmar (\$90) finished second (15th overall); Morgan Ruggeri of Johnstown (\$60) finished third; and Natalya Porcello of Albany (\$40) finished fourth. Our talented youth bowlers earned \$1,195 in scholarships; bringing the season total to \$17,315.

Livengood, Christian Chiarito of Schenectady, and Michael Taber of New Baltimore earned entries into the 2016 USBC Junior Gold Championships to be held in Indianapolis, Indiana. This extends a CDYST record as 34 bowlers have now advanced to Junior Gold through CDYST events this season.

Our next tournament is the 2016 CDYST Invitational that will begin at 9:30 am on Saturday, April 23rd at Hi-Way Recreation in Wynantskill. The event is open to any 2015 - 2016 CDYST

member, with the field limited to 60 bowlers. It will also offer optional Junior Gold qualifying to any bowler who enters. Bowlers may reserve their spot with a fully-paid entry.
