## **2015 East Greenbush Bowling Center Tournament Wrap-up**

Patrick Hoey of Latham defeated Christopher Radliff of Schenectady 233 – 205 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at East Greenbush Bowling Center on Saturday, April 11th.

The stepladder finals began with the fourth-seeded Hunter Kempton of Buzzard's Bay, MA defeating third-seeded Attilio Cardona of Cranston, RI 234 - 219. Cardona won a \$75 scholarship for finishing fourth in the Boys Division. The second-seeded Radliff then defeated Kempton 182 – 166 to set up the title match. Kempton earned a \$100 scholarship for finishing third in the Boys Division.

Hoey began the championship match with five consecutive strikes to take a 29-pin lead. Following strikes in the eighth and ninth frames, his lead increased to 50 pins as he surged to his first career title and a \$225 scholarship as the top finisher in the Boys division. Radliff earned a \$125 scholarship for his runner-up finish.

Competing in a six-game qualifying round on the WTBA Mexico City lane condition, Julia Favata of Niskayuna led following Game 1. Katie Lynch of Troy and Zachery Porter of Schenectady were the respective leaders after Games 2 and 3, before Lynch regained the lead following Games 4 and 5. In the final game of qualifying, Radliff rolled the first 11 strikes in route to a 297 game to surge into the lead heading into the semifinals. He retained the lead until the last semifinal match when Hoey capped a 730 three-game series with his second consecutive victory to finish his rise from 15th place after qualifying and 204 pins out of the lead to earn the top seed for the finals. Cardona won all three of his semifinal matches to earn the third seed; while Kempton earned one victory to become the fourth seed.

A total of 48 bowlers (28 boys and 20 girls) competed in the final open tournament of the season. The remaining scholarship winners in the Boys Division are as follows: Jonathan Bowman of Peru (\$50) in fifth place and Andrew Marotta of Ballston Spa (\$35) in sixth (seventh overall). The scholarship winners in the Girls Division were Lynch (\$175) in first place (sixth overall); Britaney Myers of Mechanicville (\$100) in second (eighth overall); Natalya Porcello of Albany (\$75) in third (14th overall); and Haley Groat of Mechanicville (\$50) in fourth (15th overall). Our talented youth bowlers earned \$1,150 in scholarships; bringing the season total to \$15,715. Groat, Porcello, Marotta, Jay Hadcock of Johnstown earned entries into the 2015 USBC Junior Gold Championships in Chicago, Illinois.

Our next tournament is the 2015 CDYST Invitational that will begin at 9:30 am on Saturday, April 25th at Hi-Way Recreation in Wynantskill. The event is open to any 2014 - 2015 CDYST member, with the field limited to 60 bowlers. It will also offer optional Junior Gold qualifying to any bowler who enters. 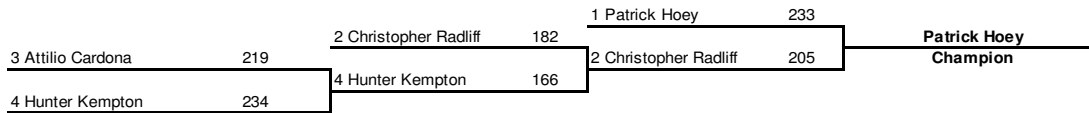
