

2014 Hi-Way Recreation Tournament Wrap-up

Justin Carl of Albany capped off a wire-to-wire victory by defeating Morgan Ruggeri of Johnstown 189 – 159 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour members-only tournament held at Hi-Way Recreation on Saturday, April 26th.

In a modified stepladder finals, fourth-seeded Jonathan Bowman of Peru (223) defeated fifth-seeded Zachary Doty of Nassau (203) and sixth-seeded Natasha Bidwell of Schenectady (165). Doty earned a \$100 scholarship for finishing third in the Boys Division and Bidwell won a \$150 scholarship for finishing second in the Girls Division. The third-seeded Ruggeri (233) then defeated Bowman (210) and second-seeded Ricky Rovelli of Albany (160) to set up the title match. Rovelli won a \$225 scholarship and Bowman won a \$125 scholarship for finishing second and third, respectively, in the Boys Division.

Carl began the championship match with a strike and three spares to take a 10-pin lead. Strikes in the sixth and seventh frames extended his lead to 28 pins. Another strike in the ninth frame enabled him to win his fourth CDYST title, second of the season, and a \$400 scholarship. Ruggeri earned a \$250 scholarship for finishing first in the Girls Division.

Boys and girls competed in separate divisions and rolled two three-game blocks on different WTBA Sport-Certified lane conditions. The top six bowlers, regardless of division, advanced to the finals.

Starting on the 34-foot Stockholm pattern, Carl began with a 220 to take the early overall lead; he ended the first round with a 694 three-game series and an 87-pin lead over Bowman. In the Girls Division, Bidwell led throughout the first round and was fourth overall with a 579 series. In the second round, bowled on the 47-foot Paris pattern, Rovelli rolled a 652 series to rise from fifth place after the first round into second overall, while Doty bowled 605 to vault from twelfth place into fifth overall. Ruggeri rolled a 643 series to surge from ninth overall into third place heading into the finals.

In this special event open only to CDYST members, 36 bowlers (23 boys and 13 girls) competed. Additional scholarship winners included: Casey Schoonmaker of Albany in fifth place (\$75) and Patrick DeVoe of Delmar in sixth place (\$50) in the Boys Division; Lindsey Rosen of Troy (\$100) in third place and Allison Carola of Mechanicville (\$50) in fourth place in the Girls Division. Our talented youth bowlers earned \$1,620 in scholarships, bringing the season total to \$15,170. DeVoe and Bidwell earned entries into the 2014 USBC Junior Gold Championships to be held from July 12 – 18, 2014 in Buffalo, New York.

Our fourth season will conclude with the 2014 CDYST Masters starting at 9:30 am on Saturday, May 10th at Town 'n Country Lanes. This event is open only to CDYST members who have competed in at least four tournaments this season. 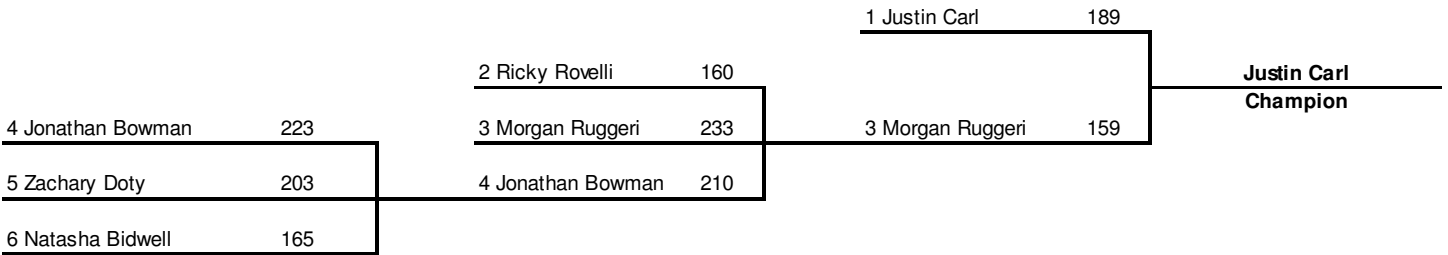
