January 2015 Hometown Lanes Tournament Wrap-up

Jonathan Bowman of Peru defeated Billy McGaffin of Amsterdam 214 – 182 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Hometown Lanes on Saturday, January 24th.

The stepladder finals began with the fourth-seeded Peter Konrad of Schenectady defeating third-seeded Morgan Ruggeri of Johnstown 171 - 168. As the top finisher in the Girls Division, Ruggeri won a \$125 scholarship. The second-seeded McGaffin then defeated Konrad 241 - 192 to advance to the title match. Konrad earned a \$75 scholarship for finishing third in the Boys Division.

Bowman began the championship match with four consecutive spares to take a 9-pin lead. Strikes in the fifth and sixth frames enabled him to expand it to 21 pins. After McGaffin closed to within 10 pins, Bowman responded with four consecutive strikes starting in the eighth frame to surge to his record eighth CDYST title and a \$175 scholarship as the top finisher in the Boys Division. McGaffin won a \$100 scholarship for finishing second.

In the qualifying round, Mariah Williams of Bloomington jumped out to the early lead with a 247 in Game 1. Bowman surged ahead following Games 2 and 3, before Williams returned to the top spot heading into the semifinals. In the semifinals, Bowman won all three of his matches to earn the top seed heading into the finals. McGaffin won two matches, including a 268 in Game 7, to vault from fifth place into second. Ruggeri and Konrad also won two of their three matches to round out the four finalists.

A field of 34 bowlers (21 boys and 13 girls) competed in our eighth tournament of the season and earned \$805 in scholarships. The season total is now \$11,340.

Additional scholarship winners in the Girls Division are as follows: Williams (\$75) in second place (fifth overall); Kasey Kosier of East Greenbush (\$50) in third (sixth overall); and Julia Favata of Niskayuna (\$30) in fourth (tied for 16th overall). The remaining Boys Division scholarship winners are Christopher Kokes of Mooers (\$50) in fourth place (seventh overall) and Robert Mengel of Albany (\$30) in fifth place (eighth overall).

Our next tournament will begin at 12:30 pm on Saturday February 7, 2015 at Uncle Sam Lanes in Troy. It is open to all youth bowlers and will also offer optional Junior Gold qualifying for any 2014 – 2015 CDYST member who has competed in at least two prior tournaments this season.

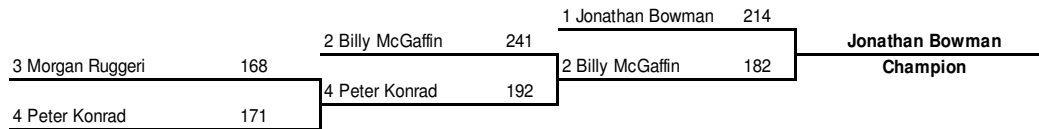
