

March 2011 Tournament Wrap-up

Tyler Mochrie of Albany won his second consecutive title, and third in four months, with a 246 - 163 victory over Casey Schoonmaker of Albany at the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Burnt Hills Lanes on Saturday, March 12th. Mochrie took the lead in the second game and led by 8 pins at the end of the qualifying round. He pulled away from the field by winning all three of his semifinal matches.

In the opening match of the stepladder finals, fourth-seeded Christopher Hanson of Ballston Lake defeated Ricky Rovelli 236 – 171. The second-seeded Schoonmaker then defeated Hanson, 185 – 166 to set up the title match. Hanson earned a \$75 scholarship for finishing third and Rovelli won a \$50 scholarship for finishing fourth.

In the title match, Mochrie had an open in the first frame, but fired nine of the last eleven strikes to pull away for his third career CDYST title and \$175 scholarship. For his second runner-up finish of the season, Schoonmaker earned a \$100 scholarship.

The most difficult lane conditions of the season made for a grueling, yet competitive, tournament. Amber Dominic of Latham earned a \$30 scholarship for finishing fifth.

In the seventh of eight CDYST tournaments, there were 15 entries. The final monthly event of the season will be held at Towne Bowling Academy on Saturday, April 9th at 1:30 PM.
