October 2010 Tournament Wrap-up

Scott Frament of East Greenbush defeated tournament leader Liz Kuhlkin of Rotterdam 208 – 198 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held on Saturday October 16th at Sportsman's Bowl. Frament, who was in sixth place after the qualifying round, fired a 231 in his first match of the semifinals to vault into second place; he split his final two matches to retain the second seed for the stepladder finals.

Kuhlkin, who was attempting to win wire-to-wire, began her day by rolling a 236, the highest game of the tournament, and steadily built up a 201-pin lead over the remaining six games. In the championship match, however, Frament jumped out to a 22-pin lead through three frames. Kuhlkin closed to within 1 pin after six frames before Frament threw a key double in the 7th and 8th frames to pull away and win his first CDYST title and \$150 scholarship prize. Kuhlkin earned an \$85 scholarship for her runner-up performance.

In the opening match of the finals, Kalyynn Carl of Albany defeated Liz Pratt of Troy 198 – 174; Pratt earned a \$40 scholarship for her fourth place finish. Frament then defeated Carl 180 – 173 to set up the title match. Carl earned a \$55 scholarship for her third place finish. The final scholarship winner was Steven Oliveira of Schenectady, who earned \$30 for finishing fifth.

In the second of eight monthly CDYST tournaments, there were 21 entries. The next event will be held at Uncle Sam Lanes on Saturday, November 20th at 1 PM.
