



2012 Redwood Lanes Tournament Wrap-up

Joe Smith of Watervliet defeated Corey Buckley of Albany 173 - 162 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Redwood Lanes on Saturday, January 28th.

The stepladder finals began with third-seeded Zachery Porter of Schenectady defeating fourth-seeded Austin Van Buren of Altamont 176 - 151. Van Buren earned a \$70 scholarship for finishing fourth. The second-seeded Buckley then defeated Porter 157 - 141 to set up the title match. Porter earned a \$100 scholarship for finishing third.

In a tightly contested championship match, neither bowler was able to gain more than a 10-pin lead throughout the first eight frames. Buckley rolled three strikes in the tenth frame to force Smith to fill 19 pins for the win; he threw a double to lock up his second CDYST title of the season and a \$250 scholarship. Buckley earned a \$150 scholarship for his second place finish.

The bowlers competed in an extended six-game qualifying round that saw Buckley jump out to an early lead. Van Buren then overtook Buckley after Game 5 and was the leader after the Qualifying Round. Smith then used a 2 - 1 semifinal match play record - bolstered by a 256 in Game 8 - to surge into the lead heading to the finals.

In the seventh of ten tournaments in the 2011 - 2012 season, there were 26 entries. Matthew Olson of Schenectady won a \$50 scholarship for finishing fifth; Allison Carola of Mechanicville earned a \$40 scholarship for finishing sixth; Casey Schoonmaker of Albany earned a \$35 scholarship for finishing seventh. A total of \$800 in scholarships was awarded to our talented youth bowlers, bringing the season total to \$6,210. Buckley and Carola earned berths into the USBC Junior Gold national tournament to be held in Indianapolis from July 14 - 20, 2012.

Our next tournament will be held at 1:00 pm on Saturday, February 18th at Ferraro's Mid-City Lanes in Kingston.
