## **2013 Spare Time East Greenbush Tournament Wrap-up**

Jonathan Bowman of Peru, NY defeated Brandon Boyer of Hudson Falls 256 - 230 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Spare Time East Greenbush on Saturday, April 6th.

The stepladder finals began with the third-seeded Boyer defeating fourth-seeded Vernon Billington II of Hartford, CT 189 - 174. Billington II earned a \$70 scholarship for finishing fourth. Boyer then defeated the second-seeded Marc Lambert of Queensbury 236 - 150 to set up the title match. Lambert earned a \$100 scholarship for finishing third.

In a match between the only bowlers to hold the lead during the tournament, Boyer began with three strikes to take a 19-pin lead. Bowman rolled a double in the third and fourth frames to close to within 10 pins. After both bowlers had a spare in the fifth frame, Bowman rolled the last seven strikes to surge to his first CDYST title and a \$250 scholarship. Boyer earned a \$140 scholarship for his runner-up finish.

In the qualifying round, Boyer jumped out to the early lead after Game 1 and opened up a 63-pin lead heading to the semifinals. However, Bowman won his first two semifinal matches to overtake Boyer and earn the top seed heading into the finals. Lambert won two of his three matches as well to earn the second seed; Billington II won his third match to jump from sixth place into the fourth position for the finals.

A total of 32 bowlers competed in the final 2012 - 2013 regular season tournament. Andrew Marotta of Ballston Spa earned a \$45 scholarship for finishing fifth; Zachary Doty of Nassau won a \$35 scholarship for finishing sixth; and Michael Hartmann of Earleton won a \$30 scholarship for finishing seventh. Our talented youth bowlers earned \$755 in scholarships, bringing the season total to a record \$11,433. In addition, during the third semifinal match, one of our bowlers toppled the 1,000,000<sup>th</sup> pin in CDYST competition.

The 2012 - 2013 season wraps up with the 2013 CDYST Masters, which starts at 10:30 am on Saturday April 27<sup>th</sup> at Town 'n Country Lanes. This event is open only to CDYST members who competed in at least four tournaments during the season and offers a scholarship fund that will exceed \$2,500. In addition, bowlers may attempt to qualify for Junior Gold.
