



2012 Spare Time Latham Tournament Wrap-up

Chad Sutliff of Valatie defeated tournament leader Casey Schoonmaker of Albany 214 - 202 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Spare Time Latham on Saturday, September 29th.

The stepladder finals began with third-seeded Christopher Hanson of Ballston Lake defeating fourth-seeded Corey Buckley of Albany 167 - 153. Buckley earned a \$75 scholarship for finishing fourth. The second-seeded Sutliff then defeated Hanson 181 - 135 to set up the title match. Hanson earned a \$100 scholarship for finishing third.

Sutliff, who was competing in his first CDYST event, began the championship match with four strikes in a row to take a 31-pin lead. Schoonmaker was able to erase the deficit and tie the match after eight frames. Sutliff responded by rolling the last four strikes to earn his first CDYST title and a \$275 scholarship. Schoonmaker earned a \$150 scholarship for his second place finish.

Under difficult scoring conditions, Dustin Netolicky of Windsor Locks, CT led after each of the first three games of qualifying before Hanson surged into the lead heading into the semifinals. Schoonmaker, who was third after qualifying, won all three of his semifinal matches to earn the top seed for the finals. Sutliff rolled a 264 in Game 7, the highest game of the day, and won two of his three matches to vault from ninth place to second. Hanson also won two matches to earn the third seed for the finals. Buckley went 3 - 0 to earn the fourth seed.

In the first of ten regular season tournaments in the 2012 - 2013 season, there were 31 entries. Austin Van Buren of Altamont earned a \$50 scholarship for finishing fifth; Lawrence Lang of Rhinebeck won a \$40 scholarship for finishing sixth; Nicholas Peckowitz of Albany won a \$35 scholarship for finishing seventh; and Netolicky earned a \$30 scholarship for finishing eighth. A total of \$885 in scholarships was awarded to our talented youth bowlers.
