## February 2016 Sportsmans Bowl Tournament Wrap-up

Justin Carl of Albany defeated Tom Hankey of Great Barrington, MA 225 - 189 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Sportsmans Bowl on Saturday, February 13th.

The stepladder finals began with the fourth-seeded Hankey defeating third-seeded Christopher Radliff of Schenectady 245 - 205. Radliff won an \$80 scholarship for finishing fourth in the Boys Division. Hankey then rolled three strikes in the tenth frame to edge the second-seeded Jay Hadcock of Johnstown 180 - 178 and set up the title match. Hadcock earned a \$125 scholarship for finishing third in the Boys Division.

Hankey began the title match by taking an 11-pin lead through three frames. Carl responded by throwing four consecutive strikes in the fourth through seventh frames to erase the deficit and take a 22-pin lead. Two more strikes in the ninth and tenth frames enabled him to lock up his sixth CDYST title (second of the season) and a \$325 scholarship. Hankey won a \$175 scholarship for his runner-up finish.

Competing in a six-game qualifying round on the WTBA Mexico City sport-compliant lane condition, Billy McGaffin of Amsterdam began with a 254 to take a lead that he would retain through the first four games. Christian Baitinger of Greenfield Center moved ahead after Game 5 before Hadcock rolled a 244 in Game 6 surge into the lead heading into the semifinals. Carl began the semifinals with a 276 to vault from seventh place into the lead. He rolled a 767 series in winning all three of his matches to pull away and earn the top seed for the finals. Hadcock won two of his three matches to become the second seed. Radliff also won two matches to rise from eighth place after qualifying into third. Hankey won all three of his matches to round out the top four.

The second-highest turnout ever for a CDYST event - 71 bowlers (49 boys and 22 girls) - competed in the ninth tournament of the season. The remaining scholarship winners in the Boys Division were Brandon Wolf of Schenectady (\$70) in fifth place; Andrew Marotta of Ballston Spa (\$60) in sixth; Jordan West of Cohoes (\$50) in seventh; McGaffin (\$45) in eighth; Peter Konrad of Schenectady (\$40) in ninth; and Baitinger (\$40) in tenth. The scholarship winners in the Girls Division were Katie Lynch of Troy (\$175) in first place (14th overall); Janelle Irwin of Schenectady (\$100) in second (16th overall); and Jenna Lemke of Delmar (\$75) in third (17th overall). Samantha Hart of Troy and Melanie Lemke of Delmar (\$40 each) finished tied for fourth (23rd overall). Our talented youth bowlers earned a regular season record \$1,635 in scholarships; bringing the season total to \$12,705.

West, McGaffin, Baitinger, Hart, Kevin Benedetto of Albany, and Jessica Shufelt of Watervliet earned entries into the 2016 USBC Junior Gold Championships to be held in Indianapolis, Indiana.
