2013 Towne Bowling Academy Tournament Wrap-up

Jonathan Bowman of Peru led wire-to-wire and defeated Zachary Doty of Nassau 257 – 252 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Towne Bowling Academy on Saturday, October 19th.

The high-scoring stepladder finals began with third-seeded Justin Carl of Albany defeating fourth-seeded Ricky Rovelli of Albany 266 - 236. Rovelli earned an \$80 scholarship for finishing fourth. The second-seeded Doty then rolled the last eight strikes to defeat Carl 260 - 237 and set up the title match. Carl earned a \$110 scholarship for finishing third.

In a title match that was close throughout, both bowlers rolled strikes in the second through fifth frames, but Bowman held a four-pin lead through six frames. They both responded with strikes in the seventh through ninth frames to maintain the four-pin gap and set up an exciting finish. Doty rolled two strikes in the tenth frame to force Bowman to fill 26 pins. He rolled all three strikes to earn his second CDYST title and a \$300 scholarship. Doty earned a \$175 scholarship for his second place finish.

Bowman and Carl began the qualifying round by rolling 299 and 298, respectively. Bowman would continue to lead throughout qualifying and won all three of his semifinal matches as he compiled the second highest seven-game series in CDYST history, with 1,635 (1,725 with bonus). Doty and Carl also won their three semifinal matches to respectively earn the second and third seeds for the finals.

There were 43 entries in the second tournament of the 2013 – 2014 season. Casey Schoonmaker of Albany earned a \$55 scholarship for finishing fifth; Jacob Rivers Jr. of Albany won a \$45 scholarship for finishing sixth; Patrick DeVoe of Delmar won a \$35 scholarship for finishing seventh; Vernon Billington II of Hartford, CT and Thomas Marr of Schenectady each won \$30 scholarships for finishing eighth and ninth, respectively. A total of \$970 in scholarships was awarded to our talented youth bowlers, bringing the season total to \$1,840.

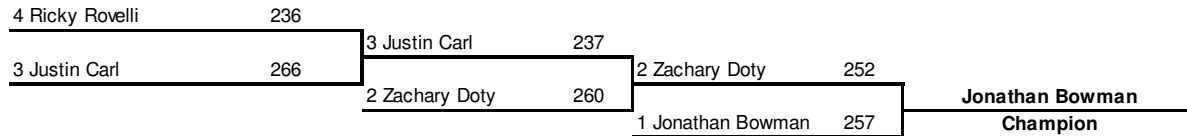
