



2013 Uncle Sam Lanes Tournament Wrap-up

Michael Hartmann of Earlton defeated Jonathan Bowman of Peru 258 - 236 to win the Capital District Youth Scholarship Tour tournament held at Uncle Sam Lanes on Saturday, March 16th.

The stepladder finals began with the fourth-seeded Justin Carl of Albany defeating third-seeded Zachary Doty of Nassau 258 - 238. Doty earned a \$70 scholarship for finishing fourth. The second-seeded Hartmann then defeated Carl 207 - 172 to set up the title match. Carl earned a \$100 scholarship for finishing third.

In the championship match, both bowlers began with five strikes in a row before each left a seven-pin. Following a strike in the ninth frame, Hartmann led by two pins. Bowman, being the first bowler to finish, forced Hartmann to get a mark in the tenth frame. He rolled the first two strikes to win his record-tying third CDYST title and a \$250 scholarship. Bowman earned a \$150 scholarship for finishing second.

In the extended six-game qualifying round, five different bowlers led at some point, with Austin Van Buren of Altamont earning the top spot heading to the semifinals. Bowman won all three of his semifinal matches to earn the top seed. Hartmann posted a 2 - 1 record to qualify second. Doty and Carl went 3 - 0 and 2 - 1, respectively to round out the top four.

In the ninth of ten 2012 - 2013 regular season tournaments there were 32 entries. Van Buren finished in fifth place and earned a \$50 scholarship; Ricky Rovelli of Albany won a \$40 scholarship for finishing sixth; and Christopher Hanson of Ballston Lake earned a \$35 scholarship for finishing seventh. Our talented youth bowlers earned \$780 in scholarships, bringing the season total to \$10,678. Bowman and Hartmann earned entries into the 2013 USBC Junior Gold tournament to be held from July 13 - 19, 2013 in Detroit.

Our final regular season event of the 2012 - 2013 season will be held at 1:00 pm on Saturday, April 6, 2013 at Spare Time East Greenbush.
